

RedCrab Calculator V is more than an update.

Version V is converted completely to a new developer system. The new system is a pre-requisite for current and future developments.

Visible feature is the new WPF interface. For example, all buttons have tooltips, which are partially supplemented with graphic or examples.

This conversion brought positive changes. On this occasion, some other changes that improve the handling were introduced. This file contains information for users who are using older versions of RedCrab.

- Due to system change, a new file format is introduced. This means that the old files of RedCrab 4.x can no longer be loaded.
- In the math editor, there must be between two variables an operator or a space. The expression ***ab*** is regarded as a variable rather than ***a * b***. This is equivalent to the behaviour at **RedCrab 4.x** on **LongTerm** mode. This change was introduced to facilitate the operation. In the old version, it can cause confusing error messages if you accidentally work in the wrong mode.
- Result boxes were replaced with a new solution. Label can be positioned on the chart boxes and images. These are easier to use, but do not have a formatting of the output, such as the old result boxes. The formatting in the label is not necessary as **RedCrab V** has a formatting on the worksheet; including prefixes, dates, etc.

Criticism or suggestions to the new RedCrab calculator are welcome.
